3. Curriculum

Faculty of Arts:

3.1. Major Program Change – Criminal Justice, BA-CJ

Moved and seconded:

Discussion:

- Data analysis approaches for curriculum changes were discussed.

4. Curriculum Change Impact Assessment Chart Revisions

A follow-up discussion took place on revisions to the Curriculum Change Impact Assessment Chart, focusing on the categorization of the "Creation of a new concentration within a major" and providing input on "Student Input" requirements.

Discussion took place on the integration of Student Impact and Student Input in curriculum submissions, including the value of incorporating student perspectives. Concerns were raised about including individual student assessments of program impact, particularly for ministerial-approval processes regarding program terminations. Ways to utilize Institutional Research and Planning (IRP) to support curriculum submissions and facilitate access to relevant data were suggested.

Specific aspects of the Chart related to Student Input were reviewed and it was agreed to remove conditions asking if there are students in the program. The committee agreed to keep the proposal type "Creation of a new concentration within a major" as a Minor Program Change.

The Chart will be revisited during the first APCC meeting in the Fall, as it is included in the Committee Orientation.
