CHOOSE YOUR COURSES

This program has been designed to be taken over two years, but can be completed in up to six years.

Complete in 2 years	Follow the sequence of courses provided in the course list on pages 4 and 5 of this guide.
Complete in 3 to 6 years	Follow a sample 3-year schedule from page 6 of this guide OR Plan your own schedule by following these steps: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Review your mruGradU8 profile (MyMRU > My Program > mruGradU8) to see your current, completed and required courses. Make note of the courses you still need to complete.2. View the courses on pages 4 and 5 of this guide to see when your remaining courses are offered.

TIPS

- To maintain full-time status, you must register for a minimum of 60% of a full course load. The course load per semester is based on the total semester hours. Specific course hours and the total hours for each semester is located in the course list.

Exceptions apply, so we recommend connecting with [MRU Financial Aid](#) for guidance.

- Prioritize courses that are prerequisites for others
- The minimum grade required to meet prerequisite and graduation requirements will be listed on your course outlines.

PRACTICUM & OUTREACH (PRC)

Practicum

- ◆ Practicum courses are delivered in person at MRU's [Student Practicum Clinic](#).
- ◆ Courses are scheduled during daytime, evening and weekend hours.

Outreach

- ◆ Outreach courses include on- and off-site practical opportunities with special populations.
- ◆ Outreach hours are scheduled during daytime, evenings, and weekends.



ONLINE (ON)

- ◆ Instructor-facilitated online courses begin and end on set dates with specific deadlines for assessments.
- ◆ There are no specific times or days to attend online lectures. Coursework is completed independently online.
- ◆ Final exams are proctored online through ProctorU (fees apply).



BLENDED (BL)

- ◆ Combination of scheduled in-person lectures and independent online coursework



LECTURE (LEC)

- ◆ In-person lectures are scheduled in a classroom.
- ◆ Lecture courses are typically scheduled during daytime, weekday hours.
