How-to

Create a login to MyCareerHub:

All credit students automatically have a profile in MyCareerHub

1. Go to [MyCareerHub](#)
2. Under Students and Graduates click Login
3. Login with your MRU credentials

Complete a mentee application:

1. Navigate to the Mentorship tab on the left-hand side
2. Click "Become a Mentee"
3. Accept Terms and Conditions (if you have any questions please contact studentjobs@mtroyal.ca)
4. Complete the application
5. Specify your answer to the question "Are you interested in participating in the Black Mentorship Program? (This program is open to MRU students that identify as Black)"
6. Select Winter 2025 and submit your application
7. After submitted, your application will be considered and you will receive an email when it has been approved

Please note that communication with the program coordinator will be through your MRU email, therefore it is imperative that you check this email on a regular basis.

Once you are connected with a mentor, you may choose to let them know if you have an alternate email you'd like to connect through. For example, Gmail.

Find and connect with a mentor:

1. In the Mentorship module, click on the three dots (ellipses) at the bottom right of the screen
2. Click "Search for a Connection"
3. If you know the name of a mentor you'd like to connect with you can type it in
4. Select different criteria that you might like to search for potential mentors. You can search by the following criteria
 - a. Availability
 - b. Preferred Method of Contact
 - c. Program Mentor Completed
 - d. Industry Mentor Works In
 - e. Area you are looking for guidance
 - f. Mentors values
5. After putting in your criteria or leaving it blank click 'Next'
6. Your search results will retrieve all available mentors, you can view their profiles to read about them
7. You can always go back and update the criteria if need be by selecting the back arrow at the top of the page
8. Once you've chosen a suitable mentor, click "Request Mentorship"
9. Career Services will vet all connections for suitability and you will receive an email when your connection has been approved with contact information
