

Call for Student Human Research Ethics Committee Faculty Reviewers

Currently, the MRU Student Human Research Ethics Committee (SHREC) is seeking one full-time faculty member (tenured or tenurable) who is committed to completing a 3-year term and is available to begin the term in October 2024.

The Committee reviews course-based research activities developed by students within classroom settings. The primary purpose of course-based research activities is to develop students' research skills. Research projects requiring SHREC review involve primary data collection on human participants. In these projects, students collect and organize these data for analysis and dissemination within the course structure (e.g., oral presentations to course members, written research paper or report to the course instructor). SHREC appointments are made by HREB Chair. Each member term is for a minimum of 3 years, with the possibility of an additional one 2-year term renewal. The Student Human Research Ethics Committee consists of faculty members led by the SHREC Chair, and is supported by staff from ORSCE.

Preference will be given to the interested candidate who:

- Has demonstrated experience in qualitative and quantitative research methods;
- Has good verbal and written communication skills, with a practical approach and the confidence to voice their opinions;
- Is committed to completing a 3-year term;
- Is available to begin the term in October 2024;
- Understands and can uphold the HREB requirement for confidentiality.

2. A statement (150 words or less) on your expertise and interest in serving on this committee.
